Notice of Nomination of Officers of Teamsters Local Union No. 938

So as not to conflict with the upcoming International Brotherhood of Teamsters Election, notice is hereby given of the nomination and election of the following officers of Teamsters Local Union No.938: President (Principal Officer), Secretary-Treasurer, Vice-President, Recording Secretary, and (3) Trustees. The term of office for these officers will be 5 years and commence on January 1, 2022 and conclude on December 31, 2026.

Nominations

Nominations will be accepted at a special membership meeting of Teamsters Local Union No.938 to be held at 275 Matheson Boulevard East, Mississauga, Ontario on August 7, 2021 at 9 am in the upstairs Union Hall. Nominations at the above noted meeting can be made either in person or submitted by facsimile or by mail petition specifying the name and signature of the nominator and seconder, the nominee's name and the position sought, and the signature of the nominee. Written nominations must be received at the Local Union office by 4:00 PM August 6, 2021. Slates must be declared on the day of nomination.

Nominations must be made and seconded by members of Teamsters Local Union No.938 in good standing with dues paid through July 2021. Any back dues or fees may be paid at the Local Union office until 4:00PM on August 6, 2021. Article XXII, Section 4(a) of the Constitution requires that all nominations be made by a member in good standing other than the nominee and seconded by a member in good standing other than a nominee.

Prospective nominees are advised to verify, in advance of the nomination meeting, the eligibility of their nominators and seconders by submitting a written request to the Local Union Secretary-Treasurer.

Nominations and Elections of Officers/Rules

The election rules are set forth in the bylaws of Teamsters local Union No.938, the Teamsters Canada Bylaws and the International Constitution which are available upon request from the Local Union.

Eligibility to Run for Office

To be eligible to run for election to any office in this Local Union, a member must be in continuous good standing in this Local Union and actively employed at the craft within the jurisdiction of this Local Union for a period of twenty-four (24) consecutive months prior to the month of nomination and must have attended at least fifty percent (50%) of the regular or divisional meetings of this Local Union during the twenty-four (24) consecutive months prior to nomination.

Election

The election will be conducted by mail ballot. Ballots will be mailed to all active members and new applicants eligible for membership in Local 938 on or about August 17, 2021. All ballots must be received at the designated post office box by 9:00AM on September 9, 2021 be counted. **Members who have not received a ballot by August 24, 2021 should contact the Local Union office at 275 Mississauga, Ontario L4Z 1X8 Phone 905-502-0062 or toll free 1-800-263-9938 to request a ballot.**

*Instructions for the completion of the ballot will be enclosed in the ballot package. This is a secret ballot vote. You should mark your ballot in private and mail your ballot, sealed in the secret ballot envelope, to your designated post office box in the postage paid envelope provided. **Do not give your ballot to anyone.***

Eligibility to Vote

To be eligible to vote in this election a member of Local Union No. 938 must be in good standing with their initiation fees and dues paid through August 2021. Members have until 4:00PM on September 8, 2021 to pay their initiation fees or dues at the Local Union office at 275 Matheson Boulevard East, Mississauga, Ontario L4Z 1X8 in order to have their votes counted. Under the International Constitution, any member on dues check off shall not lose good standing as a result of a failure by an employer to send deducted dues to the Local or to make a proper deduction from the member's pay in any month in which a member has any earnings from which dues could have been deducted.

Elected officers of the Local Union shall, by virtue of such election, be delegates to any Joint Council with which the Local is affiliated, as well as to any convention of any subordinate body which may take place during their term of office. Elected Local Union Officers shall be delegates to such bodies in the order of priority set forth in the Local Union Bylaws.

Protests

Any pre-election protests must be filed with the Local Union No. 938 Secretary-Treasurer in accordance with the provisions of article XXII, Section 5 (a) of the International Constitution. Any post-election protest must be filed with the Secretary-Treasurer of Teamsters Joint Council 52 in accordance with Article XXII Section 5 (b) of the International Constitution.

Copies of the International Constitution, the Local Union No. 938 Bylaws and the rules governing the conduct of this election are available, upon request, from the Local Union.
